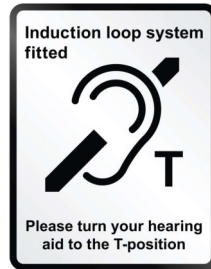

BARN PARTY - **November 4**, beginning at 5:30pm with vespers. Watch for more details to come!

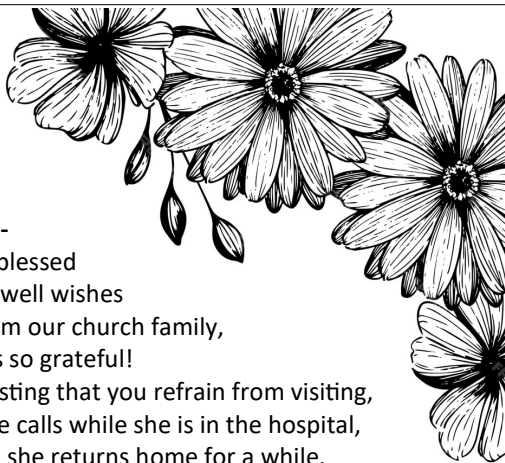
