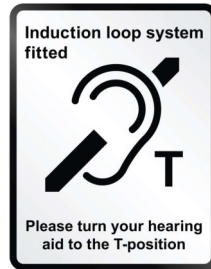

Starting in Rome, we will trace the steps of the Protestant Reformation through the Waldensian valleys and John Calvin's Geneva, hear stories of Zwingli and the Anabaptists around Zurich, and see significant Martin Luther sites in Eisenach and Wittenburg, finishing in Prague, the home of John Huss.
